DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Entries for Weimaraners will be given priority until Wednesday, March 19, 2025 at 23:00 ET, after which time entries for all breeds and mixes will be accepted in the order they were received.

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

<u>Condition of the Dog.</u> Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

The Greater Cincinnati Weimaraner Club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries per day will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to April 16, 2025 at 23:00 ET. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on April 16, 2025 at 23:00 ET. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

MOVE UPS

Move-ups for Saturday, April 26, 2025, must be received by **Wednesday, April 23, 2025**. Move-ups from Saturday to Sunday must be submitted to the Trial Secretary **by the end of Trial 2 on Saturday, April 26, 2025**. There are no move-ups between Trials 1 and 2, on the same day. **All move-ups are subject to AKC Judging Limits**.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include warm-up and waiting area, as well as the posting of running orders and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing, the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A warm-up area will be designated. One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Blank containers may also be placed in the warm-up area.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape and of the size required in the *Regulations for AKC Scent Work* for each class.

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors on tarps, matted, carpeted, hardwood, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. One or more searches may be in an elevated area, requiring less than 10 stairs with railings made of composite material. The search(es) would not start until after reaching the elevated area.

SELF-GATING SYSTEM WILL BE USED FOR THESE TRIALS

Self-gating System - The week before the trials, an armband number and a judging program will be emailed to competitors and will list the order of classes and the quantity of dogs in each class, along with any relevant site information. When you check-in at the trial, you will receive a magnet and a list of your classes. There will be a white board located at the check-in location for each element. You will place your magnet on the board of the element you wish to run, in any order you wish to run it. This will cut down on conflicts and allow each team to take as little or much time as they need to be ready.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. THIS IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY. It is not appropriate to <u>scout</u> the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5, Section 35, of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm up area."

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Crating space will be available in vehicles only. However, there will be space for pop- up tents behind the vehicles.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

High in Trial (HIT) and High Combined Division (HCD)

HIT - Only teams who participate in all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, and Buried), and qualify in each, are eligible to win HIT. One HIT winner is chosen; there is no separate HIT for the Novice A and Novice B sections. The HIT is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team will win. If there is still a tie, a coin flip will decide.

HCD - Only teams who participate in all elements AND handler discrimination classes for the offered level will be eligible for HCD. HCD is determined the same way as HIT, with the added handler discrimination qualification. The High Combined Division award is not recorded by the AKC. Teams winning HIT or HCD will earn an HIT or HCD rosette, respectively.

On each day, we will have a drawing for the **Rosey's Veteran Sniffer** and **Non-Qualifying Entry** prizes!

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Scent Work Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Greater Cincinnati Weimaraner Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Greater Cincinnati Weimaraner Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Greater Cincinnati Weimaraner Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund, unless covered by the wait list parameters.

Bitches in season, pursuant to Chapter 3, Section 15, will be refunded the full entry fee less \$10 processing fee. Notification in writing by a licensed veterinarian must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your self-gating magnet with your armband number, and a list of your classes. Once the time and location for each class is determined, all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
